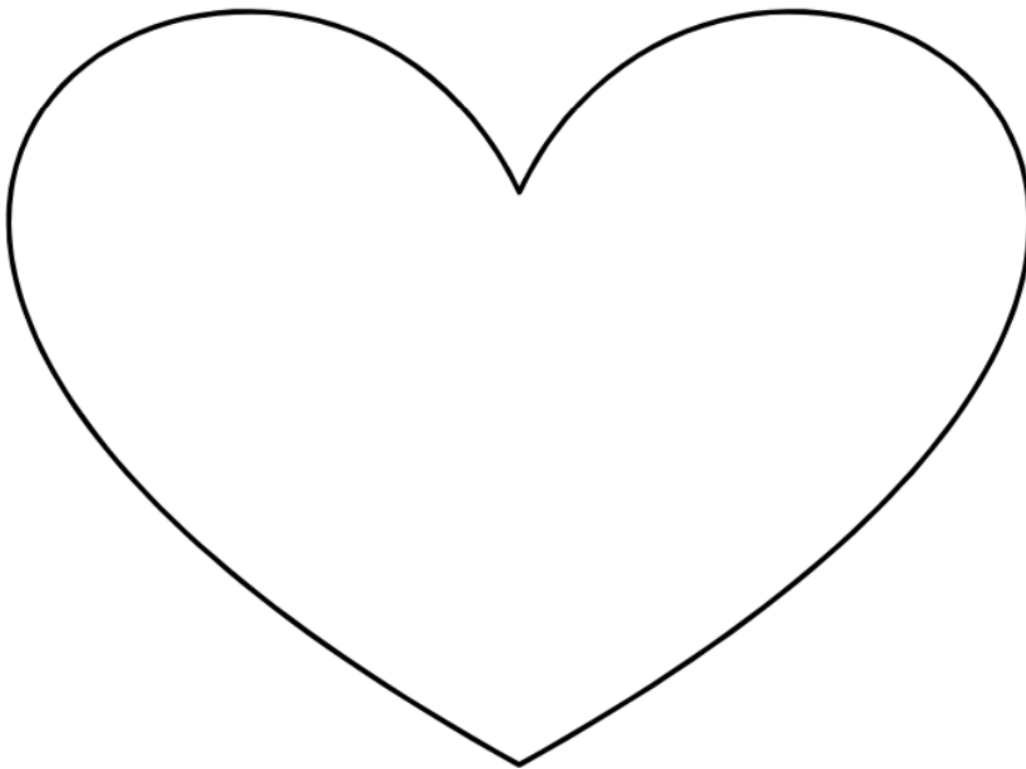

A Guide to sewing Cuddle Hearts

- Please use soft cotton or flannelette material and nothing fluffy or synthetic
- The cuddle heart is simply two heart-shaped pieces of material sewn together back-to-back, without stuffing
- The hearts need to be sewn inside out and then turned out, no raw edges, no over locking

Template



Size- 10cm to 15cm

>>Please make hearts in pairs, DO NOT STUFF they must be flat and soft with no openings
+ wash all hearts and drop off or post to:
